Today – Overcast this morning with an isolated risk for light drizzle at times. Cloud cover is expected to remain overhead through 12-1pm before becoming mostly sunny to partly cloudy and dry for the remainder of the afternoon. Variable light winds are forecast this morning, becoming east-northeasterly by mid-morning. Winds will predominantly be southwesterly and increase to 7-12 mph this afternoon but may occasionally switch to a west-northwesterly direction due to the terrain surrounding the course.

Extended forecast – The marine layer will deepen further Friday through Sunday as an upper trough digs into the Great Basin and a weak upper low traverses coastal southern California. Expect overcast to mostly cloudy skies, areas of drizzle, and perhaps some light rain through the weekend – with the greatest precipitation chances occurring during the overnight and morning hours each day. While patchy fog cannot be ruled out prior to 10am Friday morning, it is more likely that marine layer clouds remain above the course and visibility is not considerably reduced.
