THE ASCENSION CHARITY CLASSIC PRESENTED BY EMERSON - AT A GLANCE

The Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson is one of the premier Regular Season events on PGA TOUR Champions in 2021, which will give way to the Charles Schwab Cup Playoffs—a season-ending, three-tournament series used to determine the TOUR's season-long champion. Due to the circumstances related to the COVID-19 pandemic, PGA TOUR Champions has combined its tournaments in 2020 and 2021 to form one season, and the next Charles Schwab Cup champion will be crowned Nov. 11-14, 2021, at the Charles Schwab Cup Championship at Phoenix Country Club.

This week marks the inaugural edition of the Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson, which will be held annually in St. Louis. This week's tournament will feature legends of the game such as Bernhard Langer, Fred Couples, Ernie Els, Jim Furyk, Davis Love III, Colin Montgomerie and Vijay Singh to name a few.

The Ascension Charity Classic proudly stands as a premier golf tournament on PGA TOUR Champions, but this event is much more than a golf tournament. The events and activities associated with the Ascension Charity Classic provide an all-inclusive, entertaining atmosphere and the beautiful views of historic Norwood Hills Country Club serve as a backdrop for world-class golf and provide the perfect venue to mingle with friends, family and business leaders while watching the legends of the game. The first-year event's primary mission is to benefit local charities in North County and throughout St. Louis. All three rounds of the Ascension Charity Classic will be televised internationally by Golf Channel.

THE INAGURUAL PLAYING OF THE ASCENSIONS CHARITY CLASSIC PRESENTED BY EMERSON

Volunteers, fans and the PGA TOUR Champions professionals are excited to be a part of the return of professional golf to St. Louis and Norwood Hills Country Club.

One of the best fields on PGA TOUR Champions... This elite roster of 81 players collectively represents 243 PGA TOUR Champions victories, including 24 senior major championship titles.

The field also contains 19 PGA TOUR major championship wins and eight World Golf Hall of Fame members, including, Collin Montgomerie, Olazábal, José María and Vijay Singh. Eight of the top-10 players in the Charles Schwab Cup ranking are represented, including the top four: two-time Masters champion Bernhard Langer (No.1), 2003 U.S. Open Champion Jim Furyk (No.2), 2020 SENIOR PLAYERS champion Jerry Kelly (No.3), and four-time major winner Ernie Els (No. 4).

The world-class field also features two-time Ryder Cup Captain and 1997 PGA Championship winner Davis Love III, 2003 Masters champion Mike Weir, and fan favorite John Daly—who has two major titles of his own. St. Louis natives Jay Delsing and Jay Williamson will also tee it up at Norwood Hills next week after receiving the tournament's two unrestricted exemptions.

One of the primary objectives of the Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson is a genuine, philanthropic vision. To that end, the tournament has established a legacy of giving in North St. Louis County and beyond by donating \$225,000 in 2020, before a shot had even been played for tournament. The donation included \$75,000 given to each of the Ascension Charity Classic's three primary beneficiaries, Marygrove, a residential treatment and support facility for children and teens struggling with debilitating emotional and behavioral issues resulting from abuse, neglect and other trauma; the Urban League of Metropolitan St. Louis; and Boys & Girls Clubs of Greater St. Louis.

Economic impact and exposure for the region

STAYING CONNECTED AT THE ASCENSION CHARITY CLASSIC PRESENTED BY EMERSON

The Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson will permit fans to bring their mobile phones and devices to the tournament as part of the PGA TOUR Champions mobile device policy (see below).

Further, you shall not use or authorize others to use any such content or other Reproduction for any commercial or promotional purpose, or for or in connection with a media outlet (directly or indirectly) unless you and the media outlet have received an official media credential for the tournament from the TOUR.

Upon reasonable request by TOUR, at TOUR's cost and expense, you will sign any documents necessary to effect TOUR's ownership of all Reproductions. Without limiting the foregoing, you shall not collect, transmit, distribute, publish or sell any scoring, statistical, competition or other data at or from the tournament for purposes of any betting or gambling-related activity. For security purposes, you consent to the reasonable inspection of your person and property before entering the tournament, which may include metal detection. No standalone photo or video cameras (outside of mobile devices) on competition days (allowed practice days only), coolers, ladders, signs, firearms, explosive devices, etc. will be permitted onto the tournament grounds. Mobile devices are permitted to the extent they are on silent and used in accordance with this license and the posted Mobile Device Policy.

The Legends Charity Challenge presented by World Wide Technology is poised to be the tournament's marquee event in 2021. This star-studded 9-hole exhibition match will feature golf's greatest champion Jack Nicklaus and fellow World Golf Hall-of-Famer and Missouri native Tom Watson, along with former St. Louis Cardinals Hall-of-Fame shortstop Ozzie Smith and St. Louis Blues Stanley Cup-winning head coach Craig Berube to create a powerhouse foursome that will compete in an exhibition match to benefit charity

The Legends Charity Challenge will take place on *Saturday, September 11*, following the final pairing of the tournament's second round, and will begin on Hole No. 10 at Norwood Hills Country Club.

The pairings for this exciting competition will feature Jack Nicklaus and Ozzie Smith versus Tom Watson and Craig Berube in a nine-hole team scramble, match-play format. The teams will compete for a \$25,000 purse to benefit First Tee of Greater St. Louis and PGA REACH Gateway. Each hole will be given a dollar value that will be awarded per hole to the winning team's charity. Nicklaus and Smith will compete for PGA REACH Gateway, with Watson and Berube teeing it up for First Tee of Greater St. Louis. The team that has won the most money for its charity at the end of nine holes will be declared the winner of the inaugural Legends Charity Challenge presented by World Wide Technology.
