Phil Mickelson, 66-67 – 133 (-11)

- After playing his front nine in 1-under 35, Mickelson played his next six holes in 5-under, including an eagle on No. 13, to shoot 32 on the back nine.
- Mickelson, who holds a two-shot advantage over a trio of players, leads entering in the final round for the second time on PGA TOUR Champions (2020 Charles Schwab Series at Ozarks National/Won).
- Mickelson has led/co-led after six of his 11 rounds on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Mickelson has broken par in 10 of his 11 rounds on PGA TOUR Champions, and Saturday's 67 was his eighth round in the 60s. His scoring average is 67.09.
- Mickelson's second-round scoring average on PGA TOUR Champions is 67.25.
- Sunday will be the third time Mickelson plays in the last group of the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
 - 2020 Charles Schwab Series at Ozarks National (Won)

- 2020 Dominion Energy Charity Classic (Won)
- With a win on Sunday, Mickelson would become the third three-time winner on PGA TOUR Champions this season, joining Jim Furyk and Darren Clarke for the most among all players.
- A Mickelson win on Sunday would be the 17th victory by a rookie this season on PGA TOUR Champions. Mickelson is one of 11 rookies who have combined to win 16 times during the 2020-21 season.
- A win on Sunday would be the second for Mickelson during the 2021 calendar year (PGA Championship).
- Mickelson leads the field in driving distance (300.5).
- Making his fourth start on PGA TOUR Champions, Mickelson won two of his first three starts:
 - 2020 Charles Schwab Series at Ozarks National (Won)
 - 2020 Dominion Energy Charity Classic (Won)
 - 2021 Cologuard Classic (T20)

Miguel Angel Jimenez, 70-65 – 135 (-9)

- Jimenez birdied four of his last six holes to post the round of the day with a bogey-free 7-under 65 to move from T20 to T2.
- With a win on Sunday, Jimenez would become the third three-time winner on PGA TOUR Champions this season, joining Jim Furyk and Darren Clarke for the most among all players.
 - Won the 2020 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, 2020 Sanford International
- Entering this week, Jimenez has four consecutive top-10s on PGA TOUR Champions, finishing T3-T8-2nd-T4.
- Jimenez ranks T1 in the field in birdies (12)
- Jimenez will play in the last group of the final round for the fourth time this season on PGA TOUR Champions. He is 1-for-3 converting those into victories (2020 Sanford International).

Steve Flesch, 69-66 – 135 (-9)

- Flesch shot 3-under 33 on the front nine before birdying four of his first seven holes on the back nine, but bogeyed No. 18 to shoot 6-under 66.
- Flesch will play in the last group of the final round for the second time this season (2021 Shaw Charity Classic/2nd).
- Flesch ranks T1 in the field in birdies (12).
- Flesch, who has finished runner-up three times this season, is looking for his first win since the 2018 Mitsubishi Electric Classic.
- Flesch has finished in the top 10 in four of his last six starts, including three top-fives during that span.

Matt Gogel, 66-69 – 135 (-9)

- Playing on a sponsor exemption, Gogel eagled No. 3 and added two birdies en route to 3-under 69.
- This is Gogel's best position (T2) entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Making the 12th start of his rookie season on PGA TOUR Champions, Gogel's best finish is T9 (2021 Shaw Charity Classic).
- With a win on Sunday, Gogel would snap a winless streak of 19 years, 8 months, 7 days (or 7,189 days), dating back to the 2002 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.
- With a win on Sunday, Gogel would be the 12th rookie winner this season on PGA TOUR Champions and would be the 17th win by a rookie this season.
- With a win on Sunday, Gogel would become the 14th first-time winner on PGA TOUR Champions this season.

Other Notes

- **Ernie Els, Woody Austin and David Toms** are T5 at 8-under entering the final round.

- Tournament host **Jim Furyk** is T8 at 6-under after back-to-back 69s. He is tied for the fewest bogeys in the field this week (1).
- Seeking his sixth consecutive top-10 to start his PGA TOUR Champions career, **Steven Alker** is T8 at 6-under. In his first five starts, he finished T7-3rd-T9-T7-T5.
