Summary: Phil Mickelson held off Miguel Angel Jimenez by two strokes at the inaugural Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS presented by Circle K to earn his third win in only his fourth start on PGA TOUR Champions.

Phil Mickelson, 66-67-68 – 201 (-15)

- After opening with three consecutive birdies, Mickelson double-bogeyed No. 5 before adding birdies on Nos. 12, 15 and 18 en route to 4-under 68.
- This is Mickelson's third win on PGA TOUR Champions in his fourth start.

 - 2021 Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS (Won)

- Mickelson becomes the first player since Fred Couples (2010) to win three of his first four starts on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Mickelson becomes the fourth player to win on the PGA TOUR and PGA TOUR Champions in the same calendar year, joining Raymond Floyd (1992), Craig Stadler (2003) and Fred Funk (2007). (Table below)
- Mickelson becomes the third three-time winner on PGA TOUR Champions this season, joining Jim Furyk and Darren Clarke for the most among all players.
- Mickelson improves to 2-for-2 when holding a lead entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions, and 3-for-3 when playing in the last group of the final round.
- Mickelson has led/co-led after seven of his 12 rounds on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Mickelson has broken par in 11 of his 12 rounds on PGA TOUR Champions and has nine rounds in the 60s. His scoring average is 67.17.
- This is the 17th victory by a rookie this season on PGA TOUR Champions (11 players).
- Despite ranking last in the field in driving accuracy (81st/21-of-42), Mickelson led the field in driving distance (301.8).
- Mickelson led the field in birdies (17) and made the fewest bogeys (2).
- Mickelson played the par-5s in 9-under this week (four par-5s each day for a total of 12 par-5s for the tournament).

Miguel Angel Jimenez, 70-65-68 – 203 (-13)

- En route to his runner-up finish at 13-under 203, Jimenez played his final two rounds without a bogey, resulting in a 7-under 65 and 4-under 68, respectively. In all, he played the final 37 holes without a bogey.
- Jimenez' solo-second is his second such finish in his last three starts on PGA TOUR Champions (The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex) and marks his fifth top-5 finish in his last seven starts.
- This week's Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS presented by Circle K is Jimenez' 14th top-10 finish in 28 starts this season.
- A 10-time winner on PGA TOUR Champions, Jimenez claimed his two most recent victories earlier this season at the 2020 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai and the 2020 Sanford International.

Other Notes

- **Steve Flesch** birdied two of his last three holes to shoot 71 and finish third at 10-under. This is Flesch's fifth top-10 in his last seven starts, including three top-3 finishes in that span.
- Tournament host **Jim Furyk** finished T4 at 9-under after three consecutive 69s during the inaugural event. He remains No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings after earning his 14th top-10 in 22 starts this season.
- **John Daly** carded the round of the day with 7-under 65 to finish T31. Starting on No. 10, Daly birdied nine of his first 13 holes, but bogeyed No. 5 before birdying No. 6 and double-bogeying No. 8.
- **Steven Alker** (T7) earned his sixth consecutive top-10 to open his PGA TOUR Champions career.

- **Bernhard Langer** remained atop the Charles Schwab Cup standings after a T7 finish for his fourth top-10 in his last five starts.
