**Today** – Mostly cloudy and muggy conditions can be expected this morning. Scattered showers and thunderstorms will develop across Northeast Florida by early afternoon and become more numerous as we go through the rest of the afternoon into the evening as the cold front moves across the area. Storms could be strong with gusty winds, small hail and heavy rainfall. Showers should taper off by the late evening to early morning hours Saturday.

**Extended forecast** –The chance for scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will remain possible Saturday as the sea breeze moves inland during the afternoon. Otherwise, slightly drier air will provide for partly cloudy skies and a little less humid conditions as we go through the day. Partly cloudy skies and less humid conditions will continue Sunday with highs in the low 80s. Cannot rule out an isolated shower developing along the sea breeze during the afternoon, but most locations should remain dry.
