Wes Short, Jr. 34-32 – 66 (-6)

- Short hit all 14 fairways en route to posting a 6-under 66 on Friday, matching his lowest round of the season.
- It's the second time Short has led or co-lead at En-Joie Golf Club after 18 holes (2017, T20).
- At the 2016 DICK'S Sporting Goods Open, Short carded rounds of 69-66-69 en route to finishing runner-up to **Paul Goydos**, the best of his six prior starts at the event.
- A native of Austin, Texas, Short has won twice on PGA TOUR Champions (2014 Quebec Championship, 2019 Shaw Charity Classic) and owns one PGA TOUR title (2005 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open).
- Short has four top-10s this season and is currently ranked No. 31 in Charles Schwab Cup standings.

Bernhard Langer, 31-36 – 67 (-5)

- After four birdies and an eagle on the par-5 No. 8, Langer carded the best front nine of the day with a 6-under par 31 before finishing the day with a 5-under 67.
- The World Golf Hall of Fame member won the 2014 DICK'S Sporting Goods Open and has finished inside the top-10 in five of his eight previous starts at En-Joie Golf Club.
- Langer has 15 top-10 finishes this season, including one victory (2020 Cologuard Classic) and two runner-up finishes (2020 Charles Schwab Series at Bass Pro Shops Big Cedar Lodge, 2020 Timbertech Championship).
- Since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2007, Langer has 41 victories and 190 top-10 finishes. He is currently ranked No. 3 in Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- When Langer's longtime caddie, Terry Holt, was unable to work due to a previous commitment, Langer commissioned renowned sports psychologist Dr. Fran Pirozzolo, who has worked with the New York Giants, Houston Texans and the University of Houston, to caddie for him this week.

Cameron Beckman, 33-34 – 67 (-5)

- In his first appearance at the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open, Beckman posted seven birdies, two bogeys and finished with a 5-under 67 on Friday.
- Has recorded two top-10s in 14 starts in his 2020-21 rookie season on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Beckman is a three-time winner on the PGA TOUR (2001 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2008 Safeway Open, 2010 Mayakoba Golf Classic).

Other Notes

- 2012 DICK'S Sporting Goods Open champion **Willie Wood** posted a bogey-free 4-under 68 in Friday's opening round.
- **Robert Gamez** made a hole-in-one on the par-3 17th hole with a 7-iron from 185 yards. It was the third hole-in-one at the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open (2007, **R.W. Eaks**; 2015, **Mike Goodes**).
- Defending champion **Doug Barron** is T20 after an opening round 2-under 70.
- In his 35th appearance at En-Joie Golf Club, Horseheads, New York native **Joey Sindelar** is even-par through 18 holes and is currently T42.
- **Jean-Francois Remesy** was disqualified on the third hole for using a distance-measuring device.
