Ernie Els, 68-65 – 133 (-11)

- Els carded seven birdies on Saturday en route to posting the lowest round of the week so far, a 7-under 65.
- His five consecutive birdies on the front (Nos. 2-6) ties his career consecutive birdie streak (2007 Memorial Tournament).
- Through 36 holes, Els leads the field in Putting Average (1.78 putts per GIR).
- This is the third time Els has led/co-led entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions. He is 1-for-2 on converting those leads into victories:
 - 2020 Hoag Classic (Won)
 - 2020 PURE Insurance Championship (3rd)
- Els is playing in the final group on a Sunday for the third time this season.
 - 2020 Hoag Classic (Won)
 - 2020 PURE Insurance Championship (3rd)
 - 2020 SAS Championship (Won)

- Els has two wins (2020 Hoag Classic, 2020 SAS Championship) and 12 top-10s through 23 starts. He is currently ranked No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- The World Golf Hall of Fame member is one of eight players with two wins this season: Miguel Angel Jimenez, Kevin Sutherland, Steve Stricker, Jim Furyk, Alex Cejka, Darren Clarke and Phil Mickelson.
- With a victory tomorrow, he would become the first three-time winner this season.
- Els is a four-time major champion with 19 PGA TOUR titles and 47 international victories.

Cameron Beckman, 67-69 – 136 (-8)

- Beckman followed up his first-round 5-under 67 with a bogey-free 3-under on Saturday.
- The 51-year old will be playing in the final group for the first time on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Has recorded two top-10s in 14 starts in his 2020-21 rookie season on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Beckman is a three-time winner on the PGA TOUR (2001 Sanderson Farms Championship, 2008 Safeway Open, 2010 Mayakoba Golf Classic).

Darren Clarke, 69-68 – 137 (-7)

- Clarke posted six birdies and two bogeys en route to posting a 4-under 68 in the second round.
- The Northern Ireland native won back-to-back starts earlier this season at the 2020 TimberTech Championship and 2021 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai.
- Through 20 starts this season, Clarke has recorded a total of four top-10s and is currently ranked No. 14 in Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- His three PGA TOUR victories include the 2011 Open Championship at Royal St. George's Golf Club in Sandwich, England, site of this month's championship.

Miguel Angel Jimenez, 68-69 – 137 (-7)

- After playing the first 32 holes bogey-free, Jimenez carded five birdies and two bogeys and finished with 7-under 137 in the second round.
- Making his fourth appearance at the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open, Jimenez's previous best finish in the event is T6 in 2019.
- Jimenez has two wins (2020 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai, 2020 Sanford International) and nine top-10s in 23 starts this season. He is currently No. 5 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- Since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2014, Jimenez has 10 victories, winning at least once each season. He has two wins in each of the last three seasons.

Other Notes

- **Corey Pavin** made a hole-in-one on the 185-yard par-3 14th hole using a hybrid.
- **Kevin Sutherland**, who made history when he carded a 13-under 59 in the second round of the 2014 DICK'S Sporting Goods Open, will celebrate his 57th birthday on Sunday (July 4).
- Two-time B.C. Open winner (1985, 1987) and Horseheads, New York native **Joey Sindelar** is 2-over following the second round and is currently T59.
