Course Setup: Par 72 / 6,880 yards (R1: 71.247)

Weather: Partly cloudy with highs in the high-70s. Winds out of the SW at 7-12 mph.

**Schedule:** The first round resumed at 8:19 a.m. (CT), one hour and four minutes later than planned, due to course conditions caused by overnight rain. Groups will be re-paired for the final round of the 36-hole event, with tee times

running from 11:45 a.m. – 1:55 p.m. off the Nos. 1 and 10 tees.

# Tim Petrovic, 31-34 - 65 (-7)

- Bogeyed his opening hole on Sunday morning, the par-4 fourth hole, but responded with birdies on Nos. 7 and 9
  en route to 7-under 65. He started his first round on Saturday on No. 10 and held the overnight lead at 6-under
  thru 12 holes before playing his final six holes on Sunday in 1-under.
- Has finished in the top 10 in each of his last two starts (T6, Cologuard Classic; T4, Chubb Classic).
- Seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions after seven runner-up finishes since joining the Tour in 2016.

David Toms, 31-34 - 65 (-7)

- Made seven birdies in a bogey-free 7-under 65, matching his lowest round of the season (2020 Hoag Classic Rd 1; 2020 Sanford International Rd 1).
- Has finished in the top 10 in each of his last two starts (T8, Cologuard Classic; T9, Chubb Classic).
- Seeking his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (2018 U.S. Senior Open Championship).

#### Mike Weir, 33-33 – 66 (-6)

- Bogeyed his opening hole on Sunday morning, the par-3 14th, but responded with birdies on Nos. 15 and 17 to
  post 6-under 66. He was 5-under thru 13 holes and one stroke behind Petrovic when play was suspended on
  Saturday.
- Seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions after a pair of runner-up finishes in his last six events (2020 Dominion Energy Charity Classic, 2021 Cologuard Classic).

### **Other Notes**

- Olin Browne, John Daly and Doug Barron are T4 after each shooting 5-under 67 in the first round.
- Four-time Insperity Invitational champion Bernhard Langer is T12 after shooting 3-under 69 in the first round.
- Defending champion (2019) **Scott McCarron** carded 2-under 70 and sits T21.
- Mark O'Meara withdrew on Saturday before the start of the first round and Tom Gillis took his spot in the field.
- The last 36-hole tournament on PGA TOUR Champions was the 2018 Principal Charity Classic, which was shortened due to inclement weather. Second-round leader **Tom Lehman** was declared the champion after thunderstorms throughout the final day.
- The first round was suspended due to darkness on Saturday at 7:43 p.m. (CT) after three hours and 43 minutes of play. The entire field started their first round on Saturday, with each group finishing at least six holes. The first group finished 15 holes on Saturday before play was suspended.
