Extended Forecast – A front is expected to stall across southeastern Texas tomorrow through the weekend. This feature in combination with an upper-level low lingering across central portions of Texas will set the stage for rounds of showers and thunderstorms across the region through the weekend. Low temperatures will be in the upper 60s to lower 70s with high temperatures in the mid-70s tomorrow trending into the upper 80s by Monday. The strongest winds of the period are expected on Sunday and Monday when gusts around 20 mph will be possible.
