**Extended forecast** – Southeasterly to southerly flow will pump more humid conditions northward across the state on Saturday. This may lead to an isolated shower or thunderstorm developing late in the day. Otherwise, partly cloudy skies can be expected with highs in the 80s. An approaching cold front will move into Central Florida by Sunday afternoon and stalling over the area on Monday. This will provide scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms Sunday afternoon into the evening hours. The front is expected to weaken over the area Monday keeping the chance for showers in the forecast.
