**Extended forecast** – A weakening cold front will move into NE Florida Sunday before stalling across Central Florida Sunday night into Monday. This will bring the chance for showers and isolated thunderstorms to the Orlando area by mid-afternoon into the evening hours Sunday. The chance for scattered showers will be possible Monday before a low-pressure develops along the stalled front and moves across Florida on Tuesday. This will provide a good chance for rain and a few thunderstorms Tuesday before drier conditions return Wednesday.
