










PNC Championship WEATHER FORECAST

Today – Patchy fog should burn-off before play begins. Otherwise, isolated showers will be possible this morning before an approaching cold front moves into Central Florida by late afternoon. This front will bring the chance for scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms between 3-7pm before shifting into Southern Florida tonight. It will be warm and humid today with highs in the low to mid 80s.

Extended forecast – A low pressure system will develop over the gulf along the stalled frontal boundary to the south. This will bring the chance for scattered showers by late afternoon into the evening hours on Monday. The low is forecasted to move across Florida on Tuesday providing a good chance for rain and a few thunderstorms. Storms could be strong Tuesday afternoon with heavy rainfall, gusty winds and small hail. This system will pull away Tuesday night with drier and cooler conditions expected on Wednesday.
