Otherwise, it will be hot today with highs in the upper 80s with skies becoming mostly cloudy later today as well.

Monday's Forecast – Rain and thunderstorms will be likely Monday morning as a cold front moves across the area. A northwest wind of 12-18 gusting to 25 mph will make it feel cooler as well.
