Billy Mayfair, 32-30 – 62 (-8)

- Starting on Hole No. 10, Mayfair birdied Nos. 11 and 14 before closing the back nine with three consecutive birdies en route to 5-under 30. He added birdies on Nos. 1, 4 and 7 to shoot bogey-free 62, one stroke shy of matching the course record.
 - This is Mayfair's lowest round on PGA TOUR Champions (334 rounds). He had previously shot 64 on four occasions.
 - Mayfair's previous low round of the 2020-21 season was 65 (R2, 2020 Charles Schwab Series at Ozarks National).
- This is the first time Mayfair has held the solo lead after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions. He had previously held a share of the lead after the first round on two occasions (2016 Toshiba Classic, 2019 Invesco QQQ).
- Making his fifth start at the Shaw Charity Classic, Mayfair's best finish is T10 (2018). Friday's 62 was his 11th round in the 60s at this event (13 rounds).

- Making his 26th start of the season on PGA TOUR Champions, Mayfair has one top-10 (T9, 2021 Chubb Classic).
- Mayfair, who joined PGA TOUR Champions in 2016, is looking for his first win on Tour. Making his 108th start, he has three runner-up finishes, most recently at the 2018 Chubb Classic.
- Mayfair won five times on the PGA TOUR, including twice in both 1995 and 1998.
 - He made 18 starts at the RBC Canadian Open, and his best finish was runner-up (2008).

Mike Weir, 31-32 – 63 (-7)

- In his debut at the Shaw Charity Classic, Canada's Mike Weir recorded five birdies and one bogey on the front nine before birdying No. 10 and eagling No. 11 to card 7-under 63.
- Weir's 63 is his lowest first-round score on PGA TOUR Champions and ties his lowest round (R2, 2020 Dominion Energy Charity Classic) of his rookie season.
- This is the third time this season Weir has been in second place or better after the first round. The last time Weir was in second following the first round, he finished second at the 2020 Dominion Energy Charity Classic.
- In Weir's last outing, he finished T2 at the U.S. Senior Open, his fourth top-five in his last five starts on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Weir has one win (2021 Insperity Invitational) and four runner-up finishes in 20 starts this season. He has finished in the top 10 in half of his starts.

Stephen Ames, 33-31 – 64 (-6)

- Canadian Stephen Ames birdied Nos. 4-6 and added an eagle on No. 11 before back-to-back birdies on Nos. 14 and 15 to shoot 6-under 64.
 - This is Ames' second-lowest round of the season on PGA TOUR Champions (70 rounds).
- Making his 24th start this season, Ames has one win (2021 Principal Charity Classic) and two runner-up finishes among six top-10s.
- Ames, who joined PGA TOUR Champions in 2014, owns two wins (2017 Mitsubishi Electric Classic, 2021 Principal Charity Classic).

Other Notes

- **Doug Barron** and **Steve Flesch** are T3 after each carding 6-under 64. Neither of them made a bogey in the first round.
- **Ken Duke** and **Brandt Jobe** each posted 5-under 65 and sit T6.
- 2015 champion **Jeff Maggert** shot 4-under 66 and sits T8.
- Canadians **David Morland IV** and **Dennis Hendershott** are T21 after each shooting 2-under 68.
