#### **Doug Barron, 64-64 - 128 (-12)**

- Barron eagled the 18<sup>th</sup> hole to shoot 6-under 64 for the second consecutive day. After posting 1-under 34 on the front nine, he fired 5-under 30 on the back nine, playing his final four holes in 4-under.
- Barron's 64 matches his lowest round on PGA TOUR Champions (119 rounds). Before this week, he shot 64 in the first round of the 2020 Chubb Classic.
- Barron matched the low round of the day (Olin Browne, David McKenzie).
- Barron has two eagles this week, tied for most in the field (Frank Lickliter II). Barron's first eagle came on the fourth hole during the first round.
- This is the third time Barron has led/co-led entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
  - Led at the 2019 DICK'S Sporting Goods Open (Won)
  - Was T1 at the 2019 SAS Championship (Finished T3)

- A win on Sunday would be Barron's second victory on PGA TOUR Champions (2019 DICK'S Sporting Goods Open).
- Barron will play in the last group of the final round for the first time this season on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Making his second appearance at the Shaw Charity Classic, Barron finished T22 in his debut in 2019.
- Making his 28<sup>th</sup> start of the season, Barron has four top-10 finishes. His best finish is T3 (2020 Morocco Champions, 2021 Principal Charity Classic).
- While on the PGA TOUR, Barron made seven starts at the RBC Canadian Open, most recently in 2006. His best finish was T44 in his debut in 1997.

#### **Steve Flesch, 64-65 – 129 (-11)**

- After bogeying No. 2, Flesch carded six birdies en route to 5-under 65. He enters the final round T2 at 11-under 129, his lowest 36-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Flesch's 65 matches his lowest second-round score since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2017.
- Flesch will play in the last group of the final round for the first time this season on PGA TOUR Champions.
- With a win on Sunday, Flesch would record his second win on PGA TOUR Champions. He earned his first win at the 2018 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai.
- The Shaw Charity Classic marks Flesch's 27<sup>th</sup> start this season, recording one runner-up and four top-10 finishes.

#### **Stephen Ames, 64-65 – 129 (-11)**

- After recording five birdies on the front nine, Ames birdied Nos. 10 and 11 but bogeyed Nos. 12, 13 and 16 to card 5-under 65. After 36 holes, he sits T2 at 11-under 129.
- This is Ames' lowest 36-hole score since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2015.
- This will be the third time during the 2020-21 season that Ames has played with the last group during the final round.
  - Finished second at the 2020 Morocco Champions
  - Finished T8 at the 2021 U.S. Senior Open
- This is the fourth time Ames has held a share of second place entering the final round on the Champions Tour.
- With a win on Sunday, Ames would earn his third PGA TOUR Champions victory and second this season. He won the 2021 Principal Charity Classic earlier this season and the 2017 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai.
- With a win, Ames would become the 10<sup>th</sup> player this season to record two or more wins and would earn the sixth win by a Canadian on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Making his 24<sup>th</sup> start of the season, Ames has one victory (2021 Principal Charity Classic), two runner-up finishes and six top-10s.

#### **Billy Mayfair, 62-67 – 129 (-11)**

- The leader after the first round, Mayfair played his first 10 holes in even-par before eagling the par-5 11<sup>th</sup>. He added birdies on Nos. 13 and 14 before a bogey on No. 16 to shoot 3-under 67.
- A win on Sunday would mark Mayfair's first victory on PGA TOUR Champions. Since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2016, Mayfair has three runner-up finishes, most recently at the 2018 Chubb Classic.
- Making his 26<sup>th</sup> start of the season, Mayfair has one top-10 (T9, 2021 Chubb Classic).
- A victory on Sunday would be Mayfair's first win since the 1998 Buick Open and would snap a winless streak of 23 years and six days (or 8,407 days).

#### **Other Notes**

- **Brandt Jobe** carded 4-under 66 and sits in fifth place at 9-under entering the final round.
- Canadian **Mike Weir** posted even-par 70 and sits T8 at 7-under after two rounds.

- Fellow Canadians **David Morland IV** (T14) and **Dennis Hendershott** (T41) shot 66 and 72, respectively, on Saturday.
- **Olin Browne**, who started on No. 10, set a nine-hole tournament record with 7-under 28 on the back nine. He matched the low round of the day and sits T16 at 5-under entering the final round.
- **Frank Lickliter II** made a hole-in-one on No. 12 with a 6-iron from 202 yards. It is the sixth ace in Shaw Charity Classic history and the first on the 12<sup>th</sup> hole. It was Lickliter's first hole-in-one on PGA TOUR Champions.
