**Extended Forecast** – An upper-level ridge will be centered over Alberta on Saturday, bringing near record warmth to the region. The record high at CYYC is 91F/33C. The other concern is a significant influx of wildfire smoke from British Columbia as upper-level winds become westerly. Given the number of ongoing fires, smoke could become thick but likely remains elevated in nature. Very warm and smoky/hazy conditions likely persist into Sunday with wind gusts potentially exceeding 20 mph. A strong cold front arrives on Monday bringing much cooler temperatures and the chance for rain late in the day.
