Today – Smoke from British Columbia wildfires has spread across Alberta this morning and will persist through the day. Smoke could become thicker this afternoon/evening, however given the elevated nature of the smoke, air quality near the surface should remain acceptable. Temperatures this afternoon will be near record values with a high of 92F/33.3C. The current record high at CYYC is 91F/33C. Westerly winds will increase this afternoon with gusts near 20 mph/30 kmh after 3pm. **Sunrise: 6:20am / Sunset: 8:59pm**

Extended Forecast – Wildfire smoke will remain in the area tonight and again on Sunday. Air quality values will have to be monitored, however most of this smoke should remain elevated. Otherwise, hot and breezy conditions will be in place during the day Sunday with a high near 90F/32C. Gusty westerly winds should develop during the afternoon with gusts of 20-30 mph/30-50 kmh possible. The strongest gusts are expected after 3pm. A cold front will move through Alberta on Monday with cooler temperatures and the threat for precipitation developing late Monday afternoon into Monday night.
