Today – Much warmer conditions in place this morning with downsloping westerly winds keeping temperatures near 70F/21C. Winds will eventually veer to the north to northeast late this morning with some slight cooling possible. Temperatures should rebound into the lower 70s/lower 20s this afternoon under mostly sunny skies. Wind gusts of 20-25 mph (30-35 kmh) are possible this morning, before diminishing this afternoon. **Sunrise: 6:16am / Sunset: 9:05pm**

Extended Forecast – An upper-level ridge will build over British Columbia on Thursday and then shift towards Alberta for Friday and Saturday. This will lead to dry and increasingly warm conditions. In fact, temperatures this weekend could approach record values. The ridge will begin to break down on Sunday as an upper-level disturbance moves into British Columbia. Any precipitation from this system should hold off until Sunday night or Monday, however an uptick in winds are expected. Wind gusts could approach 20 mph/30 kmh during the day with temperatures making another run for 90F/32C.
