**Today** – A moisture starved cold front is moving through southern Alberta this morning, bringing a brief period of gusty winds and perhaps a passing rain shower. The threat for precipitation will end by this afternoon with winds diminishing as well. Temperatures should rebound towards the lower 70s/lower 20s with skies slowly becoming partly cloudy. **Sunrise: 6:14am / Sunset: 9:07pm**

**Extended Forecast** – The main concern this upcoming week will be the building heat as an upper-level ridge builds over the Canadian Rockies by Friday. This will push temperatures near record values for this time of year with highs in the upper 80s to perhaps lower 90s (Lower 30s Celsius). The ridge will begin to break down on Sunday and this could allow an upper-level disturbance to move into British Columbia. Right now, moisture appears limited, so precipitation chances will be capped at 10%. Some wildfire smoke could drift into the region on Sunday as upper-level winds becoming more favorable.
