Today – Mostly cloudy with a 10-20% chance for a passing shower or area of drizzle this morning as a cold front works through the region. Southwesterly winds will increase around 8am and will turn north-northwesterly behind the boundary, sustained at 13-20 mph for much of the day. Gusts of 25-30 mph will be possible prior to and just after the frontal passage around 9-10am, then will reduce to the 20-25 mph range.

Extended forecast – Expect a few showers and thunderstorms will become possible after 10pm this evening with increasing rain/storm chances overnight as a trough approaches from the west and causes lift along and northwest of a stalled out frontal boundary to our southeast. Rainfall of 0.15" – 0.30" is anticipated tonight, although localized amounts up to 0.50" will be possible where the heaviest thunderstorm cells occur.

Intermittent showers will remain likely throughout the day on Saturday, with an isolated thunderstorm risk during the morning hours. An additional 0.12" – 0.25" of rainfall is expected on Saturday. Cool and dry conditions are forecast for Sunday's under partly cloudy to mostly sunny skies.
