Today – A band of light rain showers/sprinkles will move across the Treasure Valley before 11am. Rain chances will be kept in the 20-30% range since most of this precipitation will struggle to reach the ground. Later this afternoon, showers/T-storms likely develop over the higher terrain. Some of this activity could track within 25 miles of Boise so included a low chance(10-15%) of vicinity showers/T-storms after 6pm. Gusty outflows will also be a concern with this activity. Otherwise, temperatures will reach the middle 90s today. Winds favor a northwesterly component most of the day but likely become erratic at times. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.02". **Sunrise: 6:52am / Sunset: 8:44pm**

Extended forecast – An upper level-disturbance will push eastward into eastern Idaho tonight with upper level-ridging building back across western Idaho for the weekend. There will be a threat for vicinity showers/T-storms near Boise tonight, otherwise the focus for precipitation will remain in the mountains Saturday/Sunday. Temperatures likely climb towards 100F both days with partly cloudy skies in place. Winds should remain below 15 mph this weekend.
