**Today – Rainfall yesterday: 0.12”.** More sun than clouds today with temperatures again climbing into the 90s. Showers/T-storms are likely to develop over the mountains north of Boise, however it is unlikely (rain/lighting chance ~5% between 4-7pm) any activity comes within 25 miles of the course today. Winds may become erratic at times during the day, but speeds over 15 mph are not expected.

**Extended forecast** – Hot conditions to persist Sunday with upper-level ridging situated over Idaho. Highs Sunday afternoon will approach the daily record of 101F. Additionally, some wildfire smoke could move into the Treasure Valley Sunday morning but will not impact air quality drastically. Hot conditions continue into Monday with a weak front approaching late in the day. Any shower/T-storm development should remain in the mountains.
