Today – Increasing clouds can be expected as an upper-level disturbance approaches SW Idaho. Showers/T-storms should develop in the nearby higher terrain this afternoon, especially south of Boise, however the threat for activity within the valley is very low (~5% chance). Wildfire smoke will create hazy skies once again, however air quality won't be impacted severely. Temperatures should reach the upper 90s this afternoon with westerly winds developing. **Air quality Index: 50-75 – Moderate** **Sunrise: 6:51am / Sunset: 8:45pm**

Extended forecast – An upper-level disturbance will lift northward across Idaho tonight into Friday. This will bring a low chance (~20%) for showers/T-storms to the Boise area between 12am-12pm Friday. This disturbance is expected to linger over the state through the weekend, however the main threat for showers/T-storms will remain in the mountains. While dry conditions are favored in Boise this weekend, a very low chance (~10%) will be maintained through Monday given the proximity of potential shower/T-storm activity. Ongoing, central Idaho wildfires, may also bring smoke into the Treasure Valley at times. Air quality issues are unlikely but will be monitored. High temperatures in the 90s to near 100F can be expected each day.
