Today – Clouds have increased overnight as a weak disturbance passes to the north. Even a few sprinkles or a light shower will be possible before 8am. Otherwise, clouds will clear out somewhat late this morning with partly cloudy skies during the afternoon. A pop-up shower this afternoon is also possible, but rain chances will be left at 10% or less. South/southeast winds can be expected all day, with gusts over 15 mph possible during the morning. **Sunrise: 5:58am / Sunset: 7:28pm**

Extended forecast – Moisture and instability begins to increase tonight into Saturday as a cold front slowly approaches from the west. There is a low threat for a pop-up shower/T-storm Saturday afternoon, otherwise the main threat for precipitation arrives late Saturday night into Sunday morning. There are some concerns this front lingers over the area through Sunday afternoon so precipitation chances may need to be increased. Southerly winds will be in place through the weekend with gusts over 15 mph at times.
