**Extended forecast** – A cold front will reach northern Alabama late tonight with the threat for showers/T-storms increasing. This front will be weakening as it approaches the area so showers/T-storm coverage may remain scattered in nature. Regardless, the highest threat will be between 6am-10am. The front is expected to clear the area for Sunday afternoon; however, some model guidance stalls the front over northern Alabama. If this scenario occurred, then spotty showers/T-storm development could take place during the afternoon.
