**Today** – The main area of showers/T-storms has remained 50 miles south of Huntsville this morning and continues to push away. While shower/T-storm development closer to the course could still occur, chances are relatively low (20-35%) and dry conditions are favored the rest of the day. Skies likely become partly cloudy this afternoon with temperatures reaching the upper 70s. Southwest winds at 8-14 mph can be expected with a few higher gusts at times. **Sunrise: 5:56am / Sunset: 7:30pm**

**Tomorrow** – Areas of low clouds and patchy fog are possible Monday morning; otherwise dry conditions can be expected through the mid-afternoon with increasing cloud cover. A low threat for showers/T-storms should develop after 3-4pm, however the higher threat for activity likely remains to the northwest. Temperatures are expected to reach the lower 80s with a southerly wind at 7-14 mph. **Sunrise: 5:55am / Sunset: 7:31pm**
