**Extended forecast** – A warmer and more humid/unstable airmass will spread across the region this weekend. The threat for precipitation will begin to increase as well, especially Saturday night into Sunday morning when a weak cold front arrives. This front should slide into central Alabama by Sunday afternoon with dry conditions favored across the Huntsville area. Temperatures likely climb into the lower 80s each day with southerly winds in place. Gusts around 20 mph are possible each day.
