**Extended forecast** – Intermittent light showers are possible at times throughout the day Saturday into Sunday afternoon but will be more of the isolated, hit-or-miss variety with little measurable rainfall anticipated. Areas of localized patchy fog can't be ruled out across coastal Georgia Saturday and Sunday mornings. High temperatures reach the upper 70s to low 80s through Monday with easterly winds occasionally reaching 15-20 mph during the late afternoon/early evenings; the highest chances for the upper threshold of winds will be across exposed eastern areas of the Marshwood and Magnolia courses.
