Extended forecast – Intermittent light showers may continue to move inland from coastal waters into Sunday afternoon, though little measurable rainfall is anticipated. Areas of localized patchy fog can't be ruled out across coastal Georgia Sunday morning. High temperatures reach the upper 70s to low 80s through Tuesday with easterly wind gusts occasionally reaching 15-20 mph during the late afternoon/early evenings on Sunday and Monday, increasing to 20-30 mph on Tuesday; the highest chances for encountering the upper threshold of winds will be across exposed eastern areas of the Marshwood and Magnolia courses.
