Extended forecast – Friday through the weekend, dry weather will be seen with mostly sunny skies each day. Northwesterly breezes weaken for Friday but gusts to 15-20 mph remain. Winds on Saturday weaken further and will be light/variable early, then becoming south-southwest at 10-15 mph in the afternoon. Sunday, winds will be light through 10am, then increasing from the south, with gusts up to 20-25 mph in the afternoon. A gradual warming trend is expected through the weekend with highs nearing 80F both Saturday and Sunday.
