Temperatures this afternoon are expected to reach the middle 80s.

Extended forecast – Low clouds will increase tonight with some patchy fog development also possible. Dense fog appears unlikely given forecast wind speeds. An approach front combined with an afternoon sea breeze could allow a few showers to develop Friday afternoon. Otherwise, the front will pass through the area Friday night and eventually wash out across south Florida this weekend. Dry and pleasant conditions can be expected across the Sarasota area Saturday and Sunday.
