Today – A weak cold front will move across Ohio today. A low chance (10-15%) for a shower/T-storm exists this morning (before 11am). A slightly higher threat (25-30%) for showers/T-storms may develop between 11am-2pm as the front moves through Columbus. Beyond 2pm, dry conditions are favored. Temperatures are expected to reach the middle 80s. Southwest winds this morning will become northwesterly this afternoon. Gusts of 15-18 mph are possible. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.10". **Sunrise: 6:53am / Sunset: 8:13pm**
