Today – Lingering showers remain in the area this morning, which could be moderate to heavy at times. A weak thunderstorm and some patchy marine fog also can't be completely ruled out early this morning, though chances are low for both. Rain coverage and chances decrease through the late morning/early afternoon allowing for dry conditions to prevail later this afternoon into tonight. Sustained winds up to 15 mph with gusts near 30 mph will be strongest from mid-morning through the mid-afternoon.
