**Today** – Mostly cloudy this morning, though a few brief light rain showers can't be completely ruled out into the early afternoon. Shower and thunderstorm chances increase late this afternoon into the early evening, with the highest thunderstorm threat expected between generally 2-9pm. Primary threats with thunderstorm activity this afternoon include lightning, brief heavy rainfall, and brief t-storm gusts to 35+ mph. Thunderstorms gradually weaken through the evening with the lack of daytime heating.

**Extended forecast** – A few lingering showers are possible Friday morning into the early afternoon. A weak thunderstorm also can't be completely ruled out early Friday. Rain coverage and chances decrease Friday afternoon into Memorial Day Weekend. Temperatures will also trend warmer through the weekend. Dry conditions continue into Monday with the return of summer-like temps.
