**Today** – Mostly sunny to partly cloudy this morning with increasing clouds this afternoon as a seabreeze boundary moves near or overhead. There is a 20-30% chance for a pop-up shower this afternoon – with a slight risk of a brief heavy downpour. An inconsistent breeze of 5-15 mph is forecast to arrive by midmorning, with periods of lighter and variable winds anticipated amid the predominant northerly breeze. The temperature will reach a high in the upper 80s, while the overnight low will be in the lower 70s.

**Extended forecast** – Weaker and inconsistent winds through midday or the early afternoon on Friday will allow for the Pacific seabreeze to drift overhead. This seabreeze is expected to generate an isolated coverage of showers on Friday afternoon prior to more consistent northerly winds returning between 2-4pm and pushing this boundary back towards the Gulf of Panama. A few wind gusts between 15-20 mph will be possible after 3pm Friday. Breezy northerly winds are expected to return late Saturday morning, with gusts of 20-25 mph forecast to occur in the afternoon. Dry conditions are forecast on Sunday under a mix of sun and clouds.
