Things to Know

- This week marks the 21st tournament of the 23-event regular season and 26-event 2022 Korn Ferry Tour schedule
- The Price Cutter Charity Championship presented by Dr Pepper is one of four tournaments played every season since the Korn Ferry Tour's inaugural 1990 season, with this year marking the 33rd playing of the event, all of which have been held at Highland Springs Country Club
 - The other three events with such distinction are the Visit Knoxville Open, Wichita Open Benefitting KU Wichita Pediatrics, and Albertsons Boise Open presented by Chevron
 - Only the Price Cutter Charity Championship, Wichita Open, and Albertsons Boise Open will be played for the 33rd time this year, as the Visit Knoxville Open was only contested once (2021) amid the 2020-21 combined season
- Notable past champions of the event include 2009 Open Championship winner Stewart Cink (1996), three-time PGA TOUR winner Chris DiMarco (1997), television and radio talent Colt Knost (2008), PGA TOUR winner Mackenzie Hughes (2016), Harry Higgs (2019), and PGA TOUR rookies Max McGreevy (2020) and Dylan Wu (2021)
- **Ben Silverman** (2017) is the only past champion returning to the field this week
- Dylan Wu won the 2021 Price Cutter Charity Championship presented by Dr Pepper, edging out Taylor Moore for a two-stroke victory; the win earned Wu his first PGA TOUR card at regular season's end
- Last week's winner, **Paul Haley II**, finished T6 at the 2021 Price Cutter Charity Championship
- Entering this week, 12 players have achieved #TOURBound status this season, with **Paul Haley II** and **Augusto Núñez** being the latest to cross the 875-point mark the Korn Ferry Tour is currently using as its fail-safe threshold for players to finish among The 25 and earn a PGA TOUR card at regular season's end (see The Chase for PGA TOUR Cards section for more details)
 - There are 10 #TOURBound players are in the field this week: **Byeong Hun An, Erik Barnes, MJ Daffue, Ben Griffin, Paul Haley II, Seonghyeon Kim, Augusto Núñez, Davis Thompson, Trevor Werbylo**, and points leader **Carl Yuan**

Local Ties

- **Brock Derrick**, a native of Fair Grove, Missouri, and **Carr Vernon**, a native of Poplar Bluff, Missouri, are playing as sponsor exemptions this week

- Monday qualifier **Griffen Locke** is a Joplin High School alum and 2015 Ozark Amateur

Field Notes (as of 7/19/22)

- Field is headlined by 23 of the top 25 (and 48 of the top 50) players on the Korn Ferry Tour Regular Season Points List
- Two players in the field are ranked in the top 200 of the Official World Golf Ranking: **Carl Yuan** (No. 124) and **Seonghyeon Kim** (No. 177)
- Field includes 48 past Korn Ferry Tour winners with 62 total victories, led by **Robby Shelton** with three
- Field includes four past PGA TOUR winners with seven total victories, led by **Boo Weekley** with three

- Following the conclusion of the 23-event regular season at the Pinnacle Bank Championship presented by Aetna (August 11-14), 25 PGA TOUR cards will be awarded to the top 25 players on the [Korn Ferry Tour Regular Season Points List](#), making those players “The 25”
- Another 25 PGA TOUR cards will be awarded through the three-event Korn Ferry Tour Finals at the conclusion of the Korn Ferry Tour Championship presented by United Leasing & Finance (September 1-4)
- Leading points earners of The 25 and Korn Ferry Tour Finals Points Lists receive fully exempt status for the 2022-23 PGA TOUR season and an exemption into the 2023 PLAYERS Championship, while The 25’s

leading points earner (regular season and Finals combined) receives the added bonus of an exemption into the 2023 U.S. Open Championship

- With three events remaining in the regular season, the Korn Ferry Tour is currently using 875 points as its fail-safe threshold for players to finish inside the top 25 of the Regular Season Points List and become #TOURBound (see above for the latest points list)

- Dylan Wu tied the 72-hole scoring record at the Price Cutter Charity Championship presented Dr Pepper with a 27-under 261, carding rounds of 68-65-63-65 en route to his first victory
- Taylor Moore closed with a 10-under 62, the lowest round of the week, and totaled a 25-under 263, meaning he shot a combined 52-under par across two consecutive weeks (he won the Memorial Health Championship presented by LRS the week prior)
- **Taylor Dickson** (3rd / -23) matched the highest finish of his career with a solo third, bookending a 23-under 265 with a pair of 8-under 64s

- **Paul Haley II** secured a return to the PGA TOUR with his first win since the 2012 Chile Classic; he went 3,780 days between victories
- **Austin Eckroat** finished solo-second for the best finish of his Korn Ferry Tour career; he was the outright 36-hole leader and held a share of the 54-hole lead
- Eckroat has recorded 28 consecutive rounds of par or better
- With only conditional status, Eckroat earned starts in two of the first 12 events, but Monday qualified into the AdventHealth Championship, recorded four consecutive top-25s and climbed the priority ranking via the reshuffle which set him up to play the rest of the season; he moved to No. 39 on the Korn Ferry Tour Regular Season Points List following last week's runner-up finish
- **Michael Kim** posted his highest finish in PGA TOUR-sanctioned play since his win at the PGA TOUR's 2018 John Deere Classic
