Extended forecast – A cold front will begin to sink into northern Missouri tonight and then into central Missouri on Sunday. Dry conditions will continue around Springfield tonight and most of Sunday as well. While the main threat for showers/T-storms should remain north of Springfield on Sunday, spotty development may take place after 5pm, with increasing chances after sunset. Showers/T-storms will again be possible on Monday as the front lingers near the area.
