**Today** — An outflow boundary over northern Missouri likely pushes towards the Springfield area this afternoon. Spotty shower/T-storm development will be possible in the 3-4pm hour (10% lightning chance) with a slightly higher threat for lightning developing by 6pm (20% lightning chance). Otherwise, southwest winds can be expected much of the day with gusts of 15-20 mph possible (mainly between 8am-1pm). If precipitation holds off long enough, temperatures should reach the century mark once again. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 6:11am / Sunset: 8:27pm**

**Tomorrow** – A frontal boundary will be positioned near the area Monday morning before lifting back northward Monday afternoon. While the highest threat for showers/T-storms favor areas north of Springfield, some scattered activity (30-40%) may affect the area between 6am-12pm. The afternoon hours favor dry conditions, however an isolated T-storm can't be ruled out. Temperatures will be highly dependent on cloud cover but the streak of 100F highs should come to an end. **Sunrise: 6:11am / Sunset: 8:26pm**
