**Extended forecast** – Upper-level ridging will remain positioned over the central U.S. through this weekend with daily temperatures near 100 degrees. A weak upper-level disturbance does move across the region on Friday, so a very isolated shower/T-storm can't be ruled out. By Sunday, a weak front will begin to approach from the north, however any precipitation most likely holds off until Monday. Winds should also increase with gusts of 15-20 mph becoming possible. Strongest gusts favor Saturday.
