Today – Hot conditions will persist, however a weak upper-level disturbance could allow for spotty shower/T-storm development this afternoon. Most of this activity will remain unorganized, and dry conditions are most likely to persist. Temperatures should make another run at 100 degrees but will be dependent on afternoon shower/T-storm development. Winds will be out of the southwest with a few gusts near 15 mph. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.10". **Sunrise: 6:09am / Sunset: 8:28pm**

Extended forecast – No relief from the hot conditions this weekend, however a weak cold front will begin to approach from the north on Sunday. This will cause SW winds to increase and allow higher moisture to advect into the area. Peak heat indices in the 104-108F range will be possible both days. Gusty southwest winds could exceed 20 mph on Saturday with slightly lower gusts on Sunday. The front should stay far enough north on Sunday to keep conditions dry, with a higher chance developing for Monday.
