

REX HOSPITAL OPEN
ROUND 3 INTERVIEW
June 4, 2022



VINCENT NORRMAN

Q. All right, Vincent. I want to hear about your round. Talk about your day today.

VINCENT NORRMAN: I played pretty solid. 4 under on the front, and then two quick birdies. And then nice putt on the last.

Q. How long was that putt there on the last?

VINCENT NORRMAN: It was about 30 feet.

Q. Is there anything about this course that you like or things that stick out for you on your game in particular?

VINCENT NORRMAN: It has pretty narrow fairways, I would say. You got to hit it good off the tee, which is my strength usually. And then it's in really good shape.

Q. How often do you draw back on playing in college to now? You're here in a professional round, how often do you draw back on those experiences?

VINCENT NORRMAN: Yeah, it's only been a year since I really turned pro, and we had such a good time during the -- on the courses we play. So, I mean, it's not much -- much of a difference, I would say, on the golf course. I think the experience we had in college was just -- like you see, everyone is playing good, it was so helpful for us.

Q. All right. So I know your girlfriend is playing the U.S. Open today. How has this week looked for you guys? Have you got to meet up for dinner? Or what have you all been doing this week?

VINCENT NORRMAN: Yeah, we were lucky getting the first draw, because I was really late, she was early. So we watched nine holes much each other. And then we teed off at the same time today. She didn't play great, but she played all right. I think we're just going to go for dinner tonight, and maybe ink up tomorrow.

Q. How cool is that, that she's playing in the same state, at the same time? You all are close enough to meet up.

VINCENT NORRMAN: Yeah, we are pretty lucky that way. We don't see each other a lot of, obviously, playing so much. I just grab dinner and stuff like that.

Q. All right. You versus her, who's taking the W?

VINCENT NORRMAN: I mean, she's playing major golf, I'm out here, so probably her.

Q. Ready to go head-to-head in a round, do you think she could take you?

VINCENT NORRMAN: We play each other all the time. She's so competitive. She wants to play the same tee as me. She thinks it's cheating if I'm playing ahead of you. I'm like, no. But she's -- it's really cool. She's really good.

Q. All right. So how do you feel about the round tomorrow, in contention?

VINCENT NORRMAN: Yeah, it's where you want to be. It's going to be a lot of fun. A lot of people out here, which is really cool. So it's going to be a good day.

Q. I have a question about your girlfriend. How did you guys meet? You're both from Sweden. Did you meet in Sweden, or did you meet over here?

VINCENT NORRMAN: Yeah, it's actually crazy, because we -- I mean, the golf world in Sweden is very small. So we met in Sweden. I played with her brother. He's on the European Tour. So I played a round with him. And then kind of got there and met her. And then we kind of -- yeah, since then it's been --

Q. How long has that been?

VINCENT NORRMAN: I think we're running up on three years here. So yeah.

Q. In the right direction.

Last question from me. Yesterday we talked about it a little bit, but you said your game isn't really predicated on a lot of birdies, but now out here you seem to be making them in bunches. Did something just click for you? Or is it the putter that's gotten hot? What's the difference?

VINCENT NORRMAN: Yeah, I think I'm actually -- like I said yesterday, I just hit a lot of greens. Today I got just a little closer. I made one long one on the last. But other than that, I think I just had a lot of looks inside like 9, 12 feet. And I think that's the only difference, really.
