Extended forecast – High pressure will briefly build over the Bahamas tonight with dry and cool conditions. Dry conditions are expected to persist through the day Tuesday with light winds in place. The next front will begin to approach the area on Wednesday with the latest model trends delaying most of the precipitation until late Wednesday afternoon or even Wednesday night. Until confidence increases, the forecast will maintain a 30% rain chance during the day Wednesday.
