**Extended forecast** – The cold front will wash out over the central Bahamas by tonight, however a weak piece of upper-level energy may get stuck over the northern Bahamas. Rain chances have been increased for tonight and may need to be increased for Monday as well. The next front will arrive late Tuesday into Wednesday. There remains some timing issues with model guidance, however showers and isolated T-storms appear possible Tuesday night and Wednesday.
