Tomorrow – A front will be draped across Abaco Thursday morning with areas of showers/T-storms ongoing. This front should slowly sink southward, possibly clearing the golf course by the afternoon. A slower frontal passage would keep higher shower/T-storm chance going into the afternoon hours. Southwest winds will be gusty ahead of the front but will diminish and shift to the north after frontal passage. Forecast rainfall: 0.25-0.50". **Sunrise: 6:55am / Sunset: 5:46pm**
