**Extended forecast** – Scattered showers and a few T-storms are expected to develop over the central Bahamas tonight as a cold front approaches. The lightning threat should diminish by sunrise with just lingering showers remaining possible until 10am Monday. The front will then settle over the southern Bahamas for the rest of the tournament with brisk winds and dry conditions expected over Exuma.
