Extended forecast – Dry conditions should continue through Wednesday; however it will be breezy with easterly winds pushing 25 mph. A more active pattern is expected to take shape by the end of the week with an increasing chance for precipitation. A substantial influx of moisture and instability appears increasing likely so a periods of heavy showers/T-storms will be possible. The timing of greatest impacts remains uncertain given some model disagreement.
