Today – Mostly sunny and dry through the morning. A risk of widely scattered showers/t-storms develops by 12-1pm and remains into the evening. Any storms that do form will create areas of erratic and stronger winds. Any locally stronger gusts with storms likely come from the west. Background winds become light from the east this morning, turning more southeast in the afternoon. Highs reach near 87F this afternoon and lows tonight fall to 59F. **Rainfall: Up to 0.10".**

Sunday forecast – Dry weather is expected through the morning with plenty of sunshine. Afternoon shower/t-storm will again be scattered mainly over the mountains, but a chance of some activity nearing the course is expected. T-storms may produce briefly higher gusts and changing wind directions in the afternoon. Light east to southeast breezes hold for much of the day but may become variable or even westerly at times near storms by late afternoon. **Rainfall: Up to 0.20".**
