

Today – An isolated shower may develop as early as 9am, but higher chances for showers/t-storms by 12pm onward. Any activity that does develop will include a risk of gusty winds in excess of 30 mph. Any locally stronger gusts likely come from the west. Background winds will be quite variable today but should become largely westerly this afternoon. Higher gusts are possible around showers and storms. Highs reach near 84F this afternoon. **Rainfall: 0.10-0.30"**, with locally higher amounts possible.

Extended forecast – Friday, scattered showers and t-storms are again expected in the area after 12pm. Storms may bring briefly strong gusts and cause background winds to become erratic. Outside of storms, winds on Friday will largely be from the southeast, but do expect wind switches at times through the afternoon. Over the weekend, elevated moisture levels hold with continued threats for afternoon showers/t-storms each day. Again, a risk of locally strong wind gusts exists with any cells. Background winds will again be variable at times but generally will be more variable to southeasterly in the mornings and westerly in the afternoons.
