**Today** – Pockets of showers are moving northward into northern Utah this morning with some of this activity possibly affecting the course before 9am. The lightning threat with this activity is very low (Less than 10%). Otherwise, a period of dry conditions are expected through the early afternoon before showers/T-storms redevelop. Coverage of showers/T-storms should remain limited (Chances between 10-30%) between 2-6pm. Activity likely becomes more widespread after 6pm with chances in the 30-50% range. Gusty outflow winds are concern with any T-storms. Most likely rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 6:27am / Sunset: 8:39pm**

**Extended forecast** – An upper-level disturbance will slowly move across northern Utah tonight into Saturday. Moisture levels will remain elevated with occasional showers/T-storms possible during this period. Showers/T-storms will be most likely (chances ~50%) this evening and again on Saturday afternoon. The overnight hours into Saturday morning will feature lower chances (20-40%). Heavy downpours will be possible within this activity and localized rainfall amounts during this period could approach 0.50". Drier air arrives behind this disturbance for Sunday/Monday with dry conditions favored.
