Today – Dry conditions will persist through this morning with showers/T-storms eventually developing over the mountains this afternoon. Some of this activity could push off the higher terrain and track towards Knoxville, mainly after 4pm. Winds favor a northeast direction below 10 mph much of the day, however speeds and direction may become erratic during the afternoon due to showers/T-storms. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 6:32am / Sunset: 8:31pm**

Extended forecast – The cut-off low over the area will begin to dissipate tonight into Saturday with a weak cold front eventually reaching the area Saturday night. The timing of this front likely keeps much of the Saturday dry with low chances for showers/T-storms favoring Saturday evening or early Sunday morning. Dry conditions are favored much of the day Sunday as well with another weak front arriving late Sunday night into Monday. Some fog is possible Saturday and Sunday morning; however conditions don't look favorable for widespread/dense fog currently.
